Day 1: Know Your Machine

- ❖ Height Adjustments – Fit for You
- ❖ Adjustable Handles, Ergonomic Hand-wheel
- ❖ Winding a Bobbin
- ❖ Threading your machine
- ❖ Color/LCD Touch Screen
 - Including: LED Light Settings, Stitch Modes (Baste, Cruise, Precise, and Manual), Speed Control, Stitch Length, Needle Up/Down Position, Auto/Manual Thread Trimmer, Push Button Handle Bar Controls, Auto Needle Position, Testing for a good stitch, and X and Y Encoders.
- ❖ Cleaning your machine and keeping it clean
- ❖ Threads (Which to be used on a Long-arm, size and weights of threads)
- ❖ Needles (Which needles to be used on machine, Installing new needle, and which size to use)
- ❖ Tension (How to balance thread tension, Manual method, and Towa tension gauge)
- ❖ Batting Choices (Fabric tips - Squaring the back of the quilt and why it matters)
- ❖ Loading a quilt
 - Including: Rails (What goes where?) & Options for loading your quilts (Plastic tubing, Canvas Leaders, Pinning, Velcro, Red Snappers, Zipper system).
