We are excited to present our brand new Entredeux technique. In French the definition of Entredeux is “between two”, the technique is very popular in heirloom sewing to join pieces of fabric and lace trims together. We have created a technique that allows you to create delicate Entredeux stitches on your embroidery machine. The technique is similar to our cutwork technique with the addition of another cutting stitch. Since the Entredeux stitches are so thin the additional cutting stitch allows you to trim any fine threads or fibers. There are 43 different designs including border designs that can be used to accent the Entredeux designs. These designs look beautiful on clothing or home decor items like tea towels.
