

Platform Height Adjustment for Manual Lift

These cabinets feature an adjustable platform that is leveled with a chain and eyebolt attached underneath to both the right and left sides of the platform. The chain has been installed with approximately 12 links to allow all sewing machines to work with the cabinet or table. Some adjustment may have to be made for your machine. We apologize for any inconvenience this may cause.

The first step is to determine the length of chain needed. Place the sewing machine on a flat surface and measure from the sewing bed down to the flat surface. Every two links of chain is approximately 1 inch and you will need to add one link for the screw. For example, if your machine bed is 4-1/2" above the table top, you will need 9 links plus 1 for the screw to attach the chain to the platform = 10 links.

The next step will be to shorten the amount of chain used. Please read both paragraphs so you can choose the method that you prefer.

A) Remove the screw holding the end of the chain from platform using a hex screwdriver. Move the screw over two links and tighten the screw back in the predrilled hole. Or if you prefer to permanently shorten the chain, you can use a metal cutter or tin snips to cut the extra links from the chain. (An optional suggestion from our manufacturer is to put a drop of wood or super glue in the screw hole to make sure the screw remains tight.)

B) If you don't want to remove the screw from the platform, an alternate method is to unthread the nut from the eyebolt so it hangs down from the platform. Having determined the number of links or length needed, cut the unnecessary chain on the eyebolt end. With a flat blade on a screwdriver, open the eyebolt enough to slide off the extra links and slide on the shortened chain. Return the bolt to the bracket and thread the nut back on.

Now that the chain is the right length for your machine, you can fine-tune the platform height using the nut on the bolt. If you tighten it, the platform will be raised and if you loosen it (turning it to the open end of the bolt) it will be lowered.
