

# Exercise 6 - Embroidery Design

## Free Standing Appliqué


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*We will use an existing embroidery design and add a cutting line to cut out the embroidery design to use on another project.*

**1.** File > New > From file > Browse > Look in: Creative DRAWings Samples > ASC-00069.cmx > Open > Hoop SQ(200 x 200) > Next > Cotton 2 > Next

**2.** Color Reduction > Leave at 5 > Palette > Janome > Finish

**3.** Edit > Select all > Autoborder  > To the outside > Distance 0.8mm > Type > Running > OK

**4.** CTRL + E on keyboard > Exports to Wings Modular > In sequence manager, scroll down to the black outline and click on it to select it > Move cursor over to the design and on the highlighted stitch > Right Click > Change to > Venere cut.



**5.** File > Save As > Coaster.jef > Save  
Your design is now ready to be stitched out. After the embroidery is finished stitching, the sewing machine will prompt you to put in the cutting needles to cut out the design.
