

# Monogrammed Coaster - Sew Much More!

Luminaire 2 Innov-is XP2

## Supply List

- One top fabric, 12" L x 9" W
- One piece tearaway stabilizer, 12" x 9"
- One piece backing fabric, 5" x 5"
- One piece batting, 5" x 5"
- Contrast thread for embroidery
- Pre-wound bobbin and bobbin wound to match thread
- 5" x 7" embroidery frame
- Embroidery Foot (W)
- MuVit Dual Feed
- Dual Feed ¼" Guide Foot, SA205
- Basic sewing supplies
- Rotary cutter, mat, and ruler
- Iron and pressing mat



## Embroidery



1. Prepare machine: embroidery unit and embroidery foot attached; threaded with contrast color thread and pre-wound bobbin.
2. From Home screen, press **Embroidery**.
3. Select **category 3**.
4. Touch subcategory **07**.
5. Choose your **desired letter** for monogram.
6. Click **Set**.
7. Open **Edit**.
8. Press **Size**.



9. Activate **Resize with Stitch Recalculation**.



10. Touch **OK** in the pop-up - Reset the pattern to its original size, angle and position?



11. **Reduce Proportionally** to make as small as possible.



12. Click **OK**.



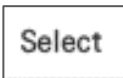
13. Press the **Stippling key**.



14. Use **left arrow** to select **4" x 4"/100mm x 100mm hoop**.



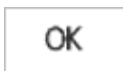
14. Touch **Decorative Fill** in the upper right corner.



16. Press **Select** to view the 42 Decorative Fill Patterns.



17. Scroll down to select decorative fill **#030**.



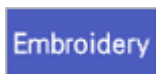
18. Touch **OK**.



19. Increase Size to **125%**.



20. Touch **OK**.



21. Press **Embroidery**.

22. Hoop 12" L x 9" W fabric and stabilizer in the 5" x 7" embroidery frame; attach frame to embroidery unit.



23. Embroider your design. When embroidery is finished, remove project from hoop.

## Construction

1. Trim embroidered coaster top to a 5" square, making sure the embroidery is centered.
2. Stack the layers as follows:  
5" square batting  
5" square backing - right side up  
5" square embroidered top - right side down
3. Attach MuVit Dual Feed Foot with ¼" Guide Foot.



4. From Home screen, select **Sewing**.



5. **Utility Stitch** and **category 1** are selected by default.



6. Select **stitch 1-03**, center needle straight stitch.



7. Activate **Pivot**.

8. Start sewing approx. 1" from a corner - backstitch at starting point.
9. Stop sewing ⅛" past embroidered design.
10. Rotate fabric 90° and continue sewing. Repeat for remaining 3 sides.
11. Stop sewing approximately 1" from last corner. This will create a 2-3" opening for turning.
12. Backstitch and cut the threads.
13. To reduce bulk - trim corners before turning.
14. Turn project right side out - use a point turner to gently push out the corners.
15. Press well - make sure seam allowance is turned in at opening where you turned your project.
16. Line up edge of coaster with guide on MuVit Foot.
17. Sew around all four sides, pivoting at corners. Backstitch at end; cut thread.

Enjoy your coaster!
