Supply List for Block #1

I have created a fun, funky quilt using mostly fabrics from my stash. I do a lot of samples for classes on plain bright fabric so I have plenty of it. The quilt is 42 x 54 inches and I used the Quilt As You Go method. The quilt uses an assortment of Westalee Rulers and free motion quilting. This is block #1 of the quilt, have fun and enjoy.



Supplies needed.

Artisan Curve Template Curved Marquise #85

Eight Point Cross Hair Ruler. I used the 12 ½ inch one and also used it to mark the edges of my sewing area.

Marking tool. I used the Clover Chaco Liner in white.

Two 14" x 14" squares of fabric for front and back of square, I suggest the top fabric should read as a solid.

One 14" x 14" thin cotton batting square. You may use 80/20 if you prefer. (I use Quilter's Dream Request).

One 14" x 14" wool batting square. Wool will give your quilting added definition and goes directly under the top layer of fabric.

40 weight thread, I used Magnifico by Superior Threads.

Free motion glider

80/12 or 90/14 needles. Topstitch are my favorite.

Sewing machine in good working order.
