

Supply List

Supplies for Place Mats

- 1 yard place mat top fabric (small print or solid)
- 1 yard backing fabric
- 1/2 yard white fabric
- 1 craft size Quilter's Dream Blend Batting (36" x 46")
- Scraps of fabric for pineapple & leaves, grape & leaf, watermelon, and pear. (6" square for each)
- 2-1/2 yards of Pellon Fusible Shape Flex interfacing (#SF101PWHT)
- Clover 1/2" Double Sided Basting Tape
- Water soluble pen that will show on fabric, and will not disappear with air or heat (Mark B Gone - #676-60, or Clover Water Soluble Pencils - #5003CV)
- Embroidery Needle 75
- Embroidery thread (for quilting too)
- 24" x 6-1/2" ruler
- 505 Spray & Fix Repositionable Fabric Adhesive or basting safety pins

Notes:

- *Fabric choice -- When quilting the place mats, the thread you use on the top must blend with the bobbin thread, since some of the bobbin thread always shows on the top. So, you can't use white on the top and black in the bobbin, and have a good outcome. Keep the thread color in mind when you select the backing fabric for the place mat. Watercolor batiks are always a nice choice.*
- *Pellon Shape Flex - Please purchase this off the bolt, instead of in small packages. The small package is only 15" wide, whereas the bolt is 20" wide. We need the 20" width!*
- *All other products -- I listed specific products because I know they work well. For example, the basting tape brand is the ONLY brand that works the way I need it to work.*

Supplies for Coasters

- One 5-1/2" square for background fabric
- One 5-1/2" square of batting
- Two 5-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles of backing fabric
- Nylon Mesh Stabilizer
- Painter's Tape
- Embroidery thread
- 75 Embroidery Needle

Supplies for Napkins

- Pre-made napkins
- Tear Away Stabilizer
- Painter's Tape
- Embroidery thread
- 75 Embroidery Needle

Supplies for Kitchen Towels

- 20" x 28" Dunroven House Towel
- Tear Away Stabilizer
- Painter's Tape
- Embroidery thread
- 75 Embroidery Needle
- Printed Paper template for placement
