### GUIDE TO SELECTING THE RIGHT NEEDLE

The Organ Needle Company works closely with some of the leading machine makers such as Janome and Brother. In this way, they have matched their expertise as the world's largest needle maker, with the particular needs of each machine builder. Realizing a machine is only as good as the needle in it, each machine maker wants to be sure to have the right needle design to enhance the performance of their machine.

We carry the largest variety of needles for sewing machines. While no one can prescribe a specific needle for any situation, we hope to explain the features of those we carry. With reasonable knowledge of the available needles, any operator can make educated decisions to deal with any sewing task.

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### **GUIDE TO SELECTING THE RIGHT NEEDLE**

BALL POINT: Ball Point needles are designed to alleviate making holes in knit or loosely woven materials. The cross fibers which constitute the knit or loosely woven materials are relatively far apart as compared to those in tightly woven materials. When a needle with a standard "set" or "sharp" point encounters one of those fibers in penetrating


SHARP (SET)

BALL POINT


the fabric, it cuts right through the fiber. This creates a hole in the fabric. The Ball Point needle pushes aside the fiber it encounters in penetration and thereby avoids making a damaging hole in the fabric. (It is also recom-

mended to use the thinnest possible needle for a particular fabric).

#### PD (Perfect Durability): PD needles have a titanium-nitride ceramic finish which makes them more wear-resistant than any other needles. When embroidering large stitch patterns or penetrating very abrasive, dense or tough materials the needle points and surface will maintain its original shape and dimensions 3 to 5 times longer. needle points will not wear down as fast as chromium plated needle points. The



use of PD needles gives you longer needle life, fewer defects due to "dulled" needle points, and increased productivity.




#### **FLAT SHANK NEEDLES**



**15x1:** HAx1, 130/705H, SY2020, SY2031, 206x15, PFx130, canu 22:15; This is the *standard* needle with a flat shank and a regular size eye for most home sewing machines and home sewer based embroidery and quilting machines. It has one groove and a regular scarf. It is available in many sizes with a sharp or a ball point and a chrome or **PD**/titanium finish.

**15x1SP:** HAx1SP, HAx1KN; This is a special version of the 15x1 for **stretch** or **elastic** materials or tightly woven **knits**. It is made to higher standards, it has a 'snake's head' shape due to a combination of a slightly bulged eye and a slightly reduced blade above the eye.



The bulged eye opens a slightly larger space in the material and the thinner blade above the eye reduces contact between the material and the needle. This reduces friction and needle heating and prevents skipped stitches. It is available in regular (sharp) and ball point.

**15x1ST:** HAx1ST, 130/705H-E; This is a special version of the 15x1 for *embroidery* and *decorative stitching*. It is made to higher standards for smoother sewing. It has an oversized eye to reduce the stress and tension on delicate embroidery thread. It also accommodates metallic threads and makes needle threading easier. It is available in regular (sharp) or ball point and with chrome or **PD**/titanium longer wearing finish.

HAx130 EBBR: This needle was developed for use in the Brother PR-600 and Babylock EMB6 machines and the new 10 needle models (probably called PR-1000 and EMB10). It is an industrial quality needle with a flat shank, reinforced blade, light Ball Point and an oversized eye. It is available in a wide range of sizes with a hard chrome finish.

**HAx130N:** 130N; This special needle has a very long, almost double length, eye. It is made for *Top-Stitching* or *Decorative stitching* and will accept heavy or multiple threads. It can also be used for *embroidery* with *heavy*, *metallic threads*. It is available in chrome or **PD**/titanium finish.

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
### Created with precision to serve all sewing demands

Organ Needle Company has managed to combine the functionality of sewing machine needles with the latest technology of ceramic coatings. These new PD (Perfect Durability) needles have titanium-nitride layered on their surfaces to extend their productive life by as much as five times that of conventional needles.


### Lasts Five Times Longer Than Chrome-Plated Needles

Productivity of automated embroidery equipment is limited by the life of their needles. **PD** titanium coated needles are significantly stronger than other needles while maintaining elasticity. This reduces needle breakage, bending and distortion. **PD** needles are more wear resistant than conventional chromium plated needles. **PD** needles provide *perfect* reliability and *durability* in prolonged stitching operations.


#### Stronger at the Point of the Needle

Organ<sup>7</sup>s process for making **PD** needles also strengthens the point of the needle. The point of a needle is exposed to high pressures causing needle wear and breakage. The strength of the needle has been reinforced while maintaining a perfect shape in order to provide greater wear resistance and durability.
